Pitt Program Council Endowed Book Fund applicants **MUST** meet the following qualifications:

- You **MUST** be an undergraduate student.
- You **MUST** have a minimum of a 2.75 QPA.
- You **MUST** be currently enrolled at the Pittsburgh campus with a minimum of 27 credits completed from the Pitt system **at the time of application**.
- You **MUST** attend the Oakland campus during the term for which you are applying. You may not apply with plans to study abroad.

Applications **MUST** include:

- Your **current resume** that includes extracurricular/work experience and activities where leadership potential can be assessed.
- Your completed **Application Form**.
- Your completed **Question Form**.
- Either a transcript or printout from PeopleSoft of your QPA

All parts of the application must be typed. Failure to meet any of these requirements will result in an ineligible application.

This award is intended for students who have been active outside of academic life, and have made a contribution to our campus community. These students may not qualify for financial aid, but are in need of assistance. As a result, an applicant's financial standing will be discussed in addition to his or hers involvement in campus life.

Your completed application is due by NOON (12 PM) on Friday, November 16th. Completed applications may be submitted to M-30 William Pitt Union. A committee comprised of representatives from The Office of Admissions and Financial Aid, The Office of Student Life, Institutional Advancement, and the Pitt Program Council will review all applications. Incomplete applications will be deemed ineligible.
